## Silver Lake resident speaks at three area energy conferences

- GE Lighting Institute (Cleveland) — Lubinski made a presentation at the annual GE Lighting Retrofit Conference in February entitled "Gaining Senior Management Support for your Lighting Retrofit Projects." - National Facilities Management & Technology Conference (Baltimore, Md.) — Lubinski is chairing a session later this month covering "State and Federal Incentives for Energy Management Projects" detailing state demand-side management programs and the Energy Policy Act of 2005. The presentation on EPACT will be made by Charles Goulding, Esq. CPA of Energy Tax Savers Inc. based in New York City. The NFMT conference draws 5,000 people. This conference takes place at the Baltimore Convention Center.

Lubinski is a life member of the Association of Energy Engineers and serves as the president of the Northern Ohio Chapter of AEE.
